By accessing and using the The Family Services, you accept and agree to be bound by the terms and provision of the TOS. In addition, when using particular The Family owned or operated services, you and The Family shall be subject to any posted guidelines or rules applicable to such services, which may be posted and modified from time to time. All such guidelines or rules are hereby incorporated by reference into the TOS. DESCRIPTION OF The Family SERVICES

2.

The Family provides users with access to a rich collection of resources, including without limitation various communications tools, forums, search services, personalized content and branded programming through its network of properties which may be accessed through any various medium or device now known or hereafter developed ("The Family Services"). You also understand and agree that the The Family Services may include advertisements and that these advertisements are necessary for The Family to provide the The Family Services. You also understand and agree that the The Family Services may include certain communications from The Family, such as service announcements, administrative messages and the The Family Newsletter, and that these communications are considered part of The Family membership and you will not be able to opt out of receiving them. Unless explicitly stated otherwise, any new features that augment or enhance the current The Family Services, including the release of new The Family properties, shall be subject to the TOS. You understand and agree that the The Family Services is provided "AS-IS" and that The Family assumes no responsibility for the timeliness, deletion, mis-delivery or failure to store any user communications or personalization settings. You are responsible for obtaining access to the The Family Services, and that access

MEMBER ACCOUNT, PASSWORD AND SECURITY

You will receive a password and account designation upon completing the The Family Service's registration process. You are responsible for maintaining the confidentiality of the password and account and are fully responsible for all activities that occur under your password or account. You agree to (a) immediately notify The Family of any unauthorized use of your password or account or any other breach of security, and (b) ensure that you exit from your account at the end of each session. The Family cannot and will not be liable for any loss or damage arising from your failure to comply with this Section 5.

7.

MEMBER CONDUCT

You understand that all information, data, text, software, music, sound, photographs, graphics, video, messages, tags, or other materials ("Content"), whether publicly posted or privately transmitted, are the sole responsibility of the person from whom such Content originated. This means that you, and not The Family, are entirely responsible for all Content that you upload, post, email, transmit or otherwise make available via the The Family Services. The Family does not control the Content posted via the The Family Services and, as such, does not guarantee the accuracy, integrity or quality of such Content. You understand that by using the The Family Services, you may be exposed to Content that is offensive, indecent or objectionable. Under no circumstances will The Family be liable in any way for any Content, including, but not limited to, any errors or omissions in any Content, or any loss or damage of any kind incurred as a result of the use of any Content posted, emailed, transmitted or otherwise made available via the The Family Services.

You agree to not use the The Family Services to:

1.

With respect to Content you submit or make available for inclusion on publicly accessible areas of The Family Groups, the license to use, distribute, reproduce, modify, adapt, publicly perform and publicly display such Content on the The Family Services solely for the purposes of providing and promoting the specific The Family Group to which such Content was submitted or made available. This license exists only for as long as you elect to continue to include such Content on the The Family Services and will terminate at the time you remove or The Family removes such Content from the The Family Services.

2.

With respect to photos, graphics, audio or video you submit or make available for inclusion on publicly accessible areas of the The Family Services other than The Family Groups, the license to use, distribute, reproduce, modify, adapt, publicly perform and publicly display such Content on the The Family Services solely for the purpose for which such Content was submitted or made available. This license exists only for as long as you elect to continue to include such Content on the The Family Services and will terminate at the time you remove or The Family removes such Content from the The Family Services.

INDEMNITY

NOTICE AND PROCEDURE FOR MAKING CLAIMS OF COPYRIGHT OR INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY INFRINGEMENT

The Family may, in appropriate circumstances and at its discretion, disable and/or terminate the accounts of users who may be repeat infringers. If you believe that your work has been copied in a way that constitutes copyright infringement, or your intellectual property rights have been otherwise violated, please provide The Family's Copyright Agent the following information:

1.

an electronic or physical signature of the person authorized to act on behalf of the owner of the copyright or other intellectual property interest;

2.

a description of the copyrighted work or other intellectual property that you claim has been infringed;

3.

a description of where the material that you claim is infringing is located on the site;

4.

your address, telephone number, and email address;

5.

a statement by you that you have a good faith belief that the disputed use is not authorized by the copyright owner, its agent, or the law;

GENERAL INFORMATION

Waiver and Severability of Terms. The failure of The Family to exercise or enforce any right or provision of the TOS shall not constitute a waiver of such right or provision. If any provision of the TOS is found by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, the parties nevertheless agree that the court should endeavor to give effect to the parties' intentions as reflected in the provision, and the other provisions of the TOS remain in full force and effect.

No Right of Survivorship and Non-Transferability. You agree that your The Family account is non-transferable and any rights to your The Family ID or contents within your account terminate upon your death. Upon receipt of a copy of a death certificate, your account may be terminated and all contents therein permanently deleted.

Statute of Limitations. You agree that regardless of any statute or law to the contrary, any claim or cause of action arising out of or related to use of the The Family Services or the TOS must be filed within one (1) year after such claim or cause of action arose or be forever barred.
